Dear Laker Parents,

You are cordially invited to attend Lake Oswego High School's **"Back-To-School Night" on Wednesday, September 22, 2010.** This is your opportunity to meet our teachers, counselors, and administrators and learn more about your student's program of studies.

A college planning session will be available for senior parents as well as an opportunity for all parents to follow their student's schedule. All of our LOHS staff will be here to answer questions and explain the many services that we provide. **Due to construction, parking will be limited. However, a shuttle bus will be available at the West End Building beginning at 6:00 and run continuously throughout the evening until 9:30.** There will also be **limited parking available on campus that may be accessed from the main entrance on Country Club Rd. and the back entrance from Lower Boones Ferry Rd.** **Additional parking will be available at Lake Oswego Junior High and the former Our Savior's Lutheran Church.** **Carpooling and allowing extra time for parking is encouraged.**

A brief assembly will begin in our west gymnasium at 6:30 p.m. This will include musical entertainment, a short welcome, announcements, and instructions for the evening. Parents will then follow their student's daily schedule of classes. **Please have your student complete his/her daily schedule on the back of this letter.** Student guides will assist you in finding classrooms.

Parents will receive a pass code tonight during their child's second period class that will allow access to our new teacher web sites and individual student grades. We have transitioned to this system to allow our students the ability to better track their assignments/tests and grades in each of their classes. We encourage our students to work closely with their teacher, advocate for themselves, and become more self sufficient as they prepare for their post high school education. As parents, we ask that you use this tool to help your child manage their academic progress and partner with us to provide the best possible educational experience for our students.

Each teacher will provide an overview of the course, class expectations, and methods of assessment. Because of time limitations, questions concerning individual students are discouraged. If you would like a personal conversation with your student's teacher, you may e-mail the teacher, or schedule an appointment. Our counselors will host a session for senior parents on College Planning beginning at 5:30 p.m. in our auditorium. This session will provide information about the college application process, post high school planning, and a chance to ask questions about your student's senior year.

We believe that this is an important event for parents to become involved in their student's education. Our teachers and support staff are looking forward to meeting you and developing a relationship that will encourage and promote student learning. We look forward to seeing everyone on Wednesday, September 22nd.
